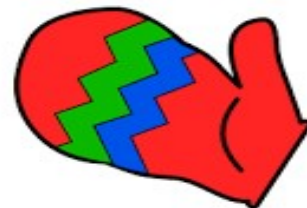


Welcome to Room B117

This week at school!

- This week we will study several winter stories including – The Mitten by Jan Brett and The Snowy Day by Ezra Jack Keats.
- We will review all introduced high-frequency words this week.
- Students will begin to work on 4-letter blends containing /r/. (crab, drip, frog, grab, trip, etc.). This can be a bit challenging since many are comfortable with 3-letter CVC words and may eliminate a letter when working on spelling.
- In Math, students will compose larger shapes from smaller shapes. We will also build 2-D shapes using toothpicks to represent sides and marshmallows to represent corners (vertices). We will finish the week with a unit test on Geometry.
- Math vocabulary: side, circle, square, triangle, hexagon, rectangle, vertice, corner, slide, stack, roll, face, solid, flat.
- In Science, we will discuss Groundhogs and predict if the groundhog will or will not see his shadow on February 2nd.
