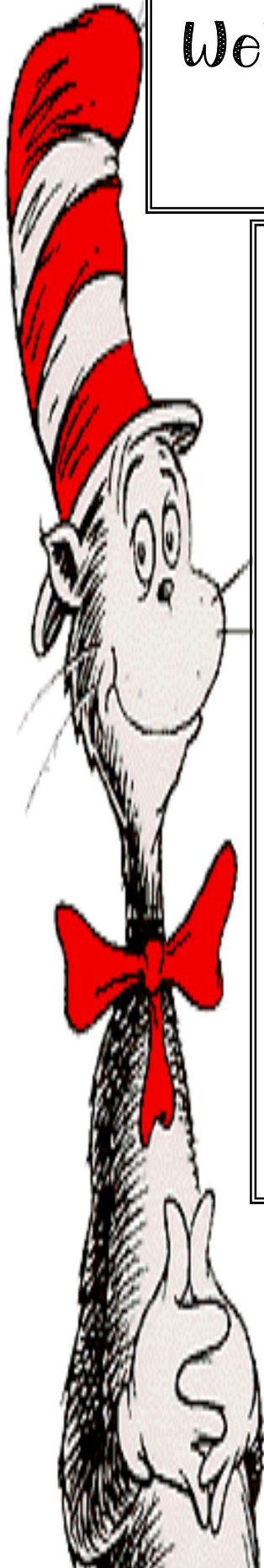
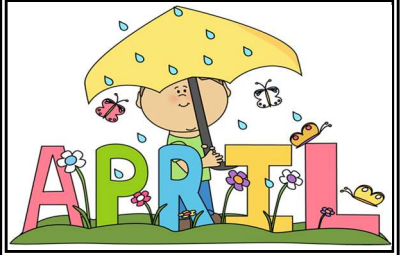

This week at school!

- This week we will read stories that discuss figuring out who you are and how to be yourself. This is an important step in growing up with confidence.
- In Reading, students will learn a new hunk & chunk /th/. This digraph can make the soft, or unvoiced /th/ sound as in path, and the hard, or voiced /th/ sound as in them.
- In Writing, we will begin our book project following the writing process that consists of brainstorming, using a graphic organizer, making a rough draft (sloppy copy), editing, and revising. To eliminate feeling overwhelmed, we work on this for about 20 minutes daily.
- In Math, students will show number pairs to 10 using objects and drawings. Our focus is to find the missing quantity in a number sentence which can be very confusing to children that are new to addition ($7+?=10$).
- Math Vocabulary: number sentence, add, subtract, equals sign (=), equation, plus sign (+), minus sign (-), total, quantity.
- In Science, we will discuss the solar eclipse and understand that the moon comes in between the sun and the Earth, thereby blocking the sun and preventing any sunlight from reaching us.
