- We will read a variety of nursery rhymes this week. These stories are passed down through generations, and are found across cultures, so they give us a sense of shared culture and community. Familiarity, language patterns, and rhythm and rhyme all contribute to making the rhymes fun to read aloud.
- This week will begin working with our poetry binder. Rhyming expands children's oral language abilities and develops phonological and phonemic awareness which is one of the best predictors of how well children will learn to read during the first two years of school instruction.

- In Math, students will see how each number in the counting sequence increases by one. We will also recognize and write the numeral 0 and understand that zero represents a group of no objects. Math vocabulary includes: more than, greater, less than, fewer.
- In Social Studies we will discuss kindness and ways to show kindness to each other.
