- This week we will read fun and silly Halloween stories. We will learn to sequence the events in a story. This is an important skill to further develop reading comprehension.
- In Phonics, we will focus on building CVC words using dry erase boards and magnetic letter boards. To help us hear each sound we break words apart by "chopping" the sounds up our arm. You may see your child working on spelling words using this strategy.
- In Math, we will work on data collection using tallies. Our data will reveal if students are *or* are not afraid of spiders. Students will continue to work on number formation of numerals 0–10.

- In Science, we will learn about nighttime animals. Vocabulary: nocturnal.
- In Handwriting, we will work on writing lower-case letters.
