





• This week will read stories that help children learn concepts such as patterns, spatial relations, and colors.

Students will identify and tell the difference between the various colors they see in the world around them.

- Our new high frequency work: said.
- In Math, children will identify whether the number of objects (to 10) in one group is greater than, less than, or equal to the number 10. Understanding how to compare numbers will help prepare our students for later subtraction.

 Students will continue to work on number formation of numerals 0–10.

 We have been practicing isolating the first sound in CVC words and this week we will work on isolating the final sound.
