





- This week we will explore wordless books and discover how to understand a story through pictures. Children will also learn to sequence a story's events as beginning, middle, and end.
- Our new high frequency word: to.
- In Math, children will sort objects into different categories based on their characteristics or attributes. Sorting helps children visualize and understand how objects are alike and different and ways that they can be organized into groups.
- In Social Studies, we will discuss the election process and have an election of our own Kindergarten style.

 Children will cast their own ballot on an important decision: Which snack should Mrs. Mulac bring to the class? The ballot selections are cookies, cupcakes, or donuts. Students will understand that their choice may not be the popular vote. We will also discuss Veteran's Day and the importance of giving thanks to our Veterans.
