This week at school!

- This week we read a variety of books about our beautiful planet Earth.
- In Reading, students will learn a new hunk & chunk /ch/. Have your child practice writing words with this consonant digraph (chip, chop, chin, such, much). Challenge your child with longer words: chart, charm, bench, bunch, lunch.
- In Writing, we will continue our published book project following the writing process. We have completed the graphic organizer, rough draft and the final copy, now we are working on our illustration. It is exciting to see what this amazing group can do!
- For Earth Day, students will compose a sentence describing our promise to the Earth. We will be sure to begin with an upper case letter, leave spaces between words, and end with punctuation, as well as our best handwriting.
- In Math, students will decompose problems within 10 involving two unknown addends. Children will use counters, cubes, and pictures to find possible solutions.
- In Science, we will learn what it means to reuse, reduce, and recycle.
- Science vocabulary: litter, habitat.
