This week at school!

• This week we will read stories about why going to school is an important part of growing up. We will discuss ways that make school fun, like making new friends and being part of a community as well as the understanding that some things are scary at first when it is unfamiliar.

• In Phonics we will focus on the consonant sound /m/, /t/, /a/.

In Math, students will count, write, and compare numbers 1-5. During Math Centers we will use dice, ten frames and dot cards to further develop students' subitizing skills, which is the ability to instantly see how many without counting. This skill plays a fundamental role in the development of children understanding number sense leading to higher level addition. We will also continue to focus on proper number formation.
In Science, students will become scientists!

We will examine apples, participate in a taste test experiment, then graph our data. We will also discuss seasonal changes as we slide into Fall.
