This week at school!

• This week we will read alphabet books to help us better understand letter recognition and letter sound. We will also continue to practice rhyming skills by identifying rhymes as well as producing rhymes.

In Phonics, we will focus on the consonant sound /m/, /t/, /f/, /n/, /p/, /s/and the vowel sounds /a/ /i/.
We have been breaking words into individual sounds (cat = /c/ /a/ /t/). You may see your child "chop" up their arm to break a word into individual sounds.

 In Math, children will show how to compose (make) numbers 3, 4, & 5 in more than one way. We will continue to work on recognizing quantities in tens frames.

During Math Centers, we will continue to work on students' subitizing skills, which is the ability to instantly see how many without counting. This skill plays a fundamental role in the development of children understanding number sense leading to higher-level addition. We will also continue to focus on proper number formation.
